

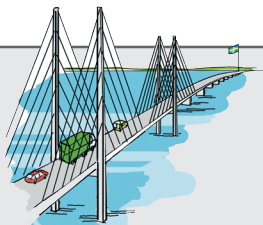


To those of you who prefer to read in English

Welcome to one of Sweden's livestock farms!

Sweden is free from many of the contagious animal diseases found throughout Europe. Examples of such diseases are salmonella, BVDV, classical swine fever and PRRS.

In order to preserve the current good status of health among Swedish farm animals and prevent the spread of disease and infection, we kindly ask you to observe some simple but very important rules when in contact with farm animals in Sweden.



48 hour rule

If you have been in contact with farm animals abroad, wait 48 hours before you come into contact with farm animals in Sweden.



Wait five days

Wait five full days after visiting livestock in a country that is not free from foot and mouth disease



No food waste

Never give food waste to animals. Do not dispose of food waste in nature.



Wash your hands

Always wash your hands before entering the stable/farm building.



Clothing

Use the farm's own work clothes and shoes or boots
